
- D) Several of our Alumni, past Dean, Directors and High Achievers were duly honored and acknowledged.

- I) Representative Members GMCAAN, Mumbai also made onsite visit to the KEM Hospital to do assessment and demonstration of the "SMART PODIUM"






12) Dr. Vaibhav Bhanawat shared the Photograph with Mrs. Kadasne and handed over the Cheque to Dr. Dani.
