The entire event was well reported in local newspapers News Channels complimenting the GMC and the Alumni Association for encouraging the meritorious students by awarding Gold Medals.

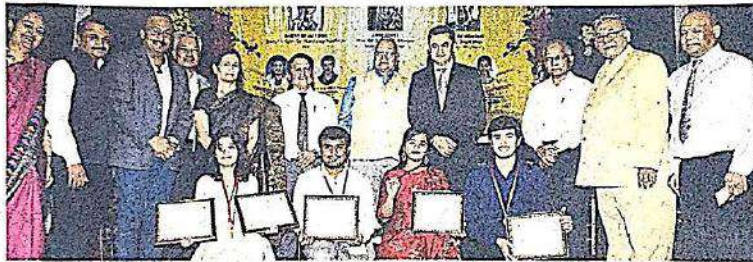
मेडिकल पीजी की 1000 सीटें बढ़ेंगी!
